

**For the safety of everyone, we would be grateful if you could observe the following guidelines when attending a service at All Saints.**

**PLEASE**

- Come prepared to queue outside as we will be directing people to their seats individually and recording names of those attending in case 'test and trace' is required
- Use hand sanitiser when you enter the building
- Wear a face covering inside the church
- Sit where you are directed to ensure that you are 2 metres from anyone not in your household
- For Morning Worship all the words will be on the screen and for Holy Communion we will use service sheets which will be quarantined until the following month.
- No singing is allowed so we will sit quietly whilst Paul or recordings are playing.
- For Holy Communion please wait in your seat until called forward. Go forward down the middle aisle and return to your seat via the nearest side aisle.
- There will be a plate at the back for the collection at the end of the service. Please consider making a regular donation by standing order if you are able. Do pick up a leaflet about this at the door.
- The toilet, kitchen and children's corner are out of use at present
- Please wait in your pew at the end of the service until directed to leave
- When leaving do not congregate at the back of church – if you wish to chat, do this outside
